International Media Distribution



Introduction:

New Zealand News was commissioned by organizers of the 100% Pure New Zealand Winter Games to maximise the international television coverage of 100% Pure New Zealand Winter Games 2011. In addition to the media relations activity a post event broll package was produced on location in Queenstown.

Some general observations:

- The 100% Pure New Zealand Winter Games 2011has, without doubt, a higher profile than 2009.
- Most interested broadcasters accessed the VNRs. This may have impacted on uptake of the b-roll as they already had content.
- National broadcasters are generally interested in coverage only if they have nationals participating and preferably featuring on the podium.
- Most common feedback from European broadcasters is that is felt 'odd' to have winter sports at this time – very focused on football and the World Athletics Championships taking place at the same time.
- The VNRs have been successful and would recommend they continue possibly
 with a more international focus for events that have a New Zealand winner. Press
 releases with story background could also be added to the FTP to provide all
 detail in one place. The FTP content has also been added to the library of a
 number of broadcasters.
- The production was very good and content visually appealing to broadcasters.

Approach:

Contact with broadcasters commenced at the end of 2010 in order to ensure understanding of the event and to increase it's profile among sports and sports news producers. Broadcasters in the following countries were contacted on a regular basis in the months preceding the event.

These countries and regions were selected for several reasons:

- 1. They represent regions of focus for New Zealand Inc.
- 2. They are countries that have an interest in winter sports
- 3. They have athletes that actively participate in the sports that feature in the Winter Games.
- 4. They have athletes representing their country at the Winter Games 2011.



1. FTP: Daily highlights (VNR)

Many of the broadcasters contacted in the final lead up to the games indicated an interest in accessing daily highlights. As a result, prior to the event and each day during the event, email notification detailing the content available on the FTP server, a reminder of how to access the content and any associated press release (See appendix 2 for example email) was sent to the broadcasters and agencies listed below. In some instances a number of producers / desks were targeted within each organisation to maximise the potential for use.

Value of media coverage

Comparing the value of media exposure in an editorial context with the cost of 'equivalent' advertising has long been acknowledged as a blunt metric in terms of evaluating return on investment. This coupled with the increasing fragmentation and multi-media nature of channels does not lend itself to a direct comparison.

However, in terms of establishing the value of media coverage there are some key questions that can be asked to establish whether or not the exercise has been worthwhile.

- Did it reach the target audience?
- What was the quality of the medium it appeared in?
- Did it deliver key messages?
- Was the coverage positive?

In terms of the 100% Pure New Zealand Winter Games it would be fair to say that given the media coverage, known to-date, it has been of value to the event.

1. Did it reach the target audience?

In terms of a target audience, a key objective of the international media relations campaign was to achieve coverage in key countries for the following reasons:

- They represent regions of focus for the New Zealand Government, a key investor in the event.
- They are countries that have an interest in winter sports and have athletes that actively participate in the sports that feature in the Winter Games.
- And most specifically have athletes representing their country at the Winter Games 2011.

With the exception of a couple, the countries identified as 'targets' all received some coverage of the Winter Games. Given that the majority of this coverage was in the form of a sports feature or sports news item, the audiences are, for the most part the general public with an interest in sport.

In addition to television coverage, known on-line content placement has been reasonably successful. Given the need for 'self-selection' to view the content and niche nature of many websites, the audience for some of these could be described as much more active.

In conclusion it is fair to say, that given the mix of media, the coverage achieved of the 100% Pure New Zealand Winter Games will assist in raising the profile of the event with both the general viewing public and potential competitors in the event.

2. Quality of medium?

As previously stated, coverage of the 100% Pure Winter Games was across a wide variety of media including a number of pan-regional and significant national broadcasters. In addition to this television coverage on-line content featured on a number of high profile sports and new related websites.

3. Delivery of key messages?

In terms of key messages for the event while none were identified to be integral to the content distributed, it is clear that the games are establishing themselves as a major international Winter Sports competition. With this in mind, the event delivered key messages on three levels:



Appendix 1. News of the Day 29th August

As is often the case a number of high interest sports and news stories competed for bulletin time on the day of the feed and a couple of days following. Highlights include:

• World Athletics 2011: Bolt disqualified as Blake wins gold

Jamaica's Usain Bolt was disqualified from the final of the men's 100m at the World Athletics Championships as countryman Yohan Blake took gold.

- World Athletics 2011: Christine Ohuruogu disqualified from 400m heats. Christine Ohuruogu is out of the 400m at the World Athletics Championships after being disqualified in the heats.
- Notting Hill Carnival: Joyful times after the riots

In the aftermath of this summer's riots, the organisers of the Notting Hill Carnival said they wanted to put on an "uplifting" event for London.

Beyonce reveals pregnancy at MTV Music Video Awards

Singer Beyonce Knowles has outlined a baby bump to photographers after months of speculation she might be pregnant.

• Baghdad mosque attack: Suicide bomber kills at least 28

A suicide bomber has killed at least 28 people and wounded at least 30 more after blowing himself up inside a Sunni mosque in the Iraqi capital Baghdad, local officials say.

• London riots arrests reach 2,000

Met Police says The Metropolitan Police said it has now arrested more than 2,000 people in connection with rioting and looting across London.

• Libya crisis: Gaddafi 'in poor position to negotiate'

Libyan leader Col Muammar Gaddafi is ready to begin talks to transfer power, a US media outlet has been told.

Hurricane Irene is a 'large and dangerous' storm

Hurricane Irene remains a large and dangerous storm and should be taken seriously, US Homeland Security Secretary Janet Napolitano has said.

• Pakistan ex-MP Waja Karim Dad dies in Karachi violence

At least 13 people, including a former parliamentarian, have been killed in ongoing politically-motivated violence in Pakistan's southern port of Karachi.

Nigeria launches two satellites

Nigeria has successfully launched two Earth observation satellites which could be used to monitor weather in a region seasonally ravaged by disasters.

Syria forces 'in new crackdown'

Story Summary

A who's who of the world's top winter sports athletes were in Queenstown, Lake Wanaka, Naseby and Dunedin for the second 100% Pure New Zealand Winter Games.

The event featured some of the biggest names in winter sports and attracted over 1,000 athletes from 50 nations who participated in 38 events over 18 days.

Events included; Cross Country, Cross Country Sprint, Freeski Slopestyle, Snowboard Cross, FreeSki Big, Snowboard Slopestyle, Giant Slalom, Alpine Skiing Slalom, Men's Ski Cross, Snowboard Halfpipe World Cup, Curling, Figure Skating, Speed Skating, Ice hockey.

The Winter Games are the initiative of Sir Eion Edgar, former president of the New Zealand Olympic Committee and a key feature is that able-bodied athletes compete alongside 'adaptive' competitors in alpine and cross-country events.

The games have the support of the NZ Olympic Committee and the NZ Government and provide an excellent preparation event for athletes who are working towards competing in the Winter Olympics. The 2009 event provided the opportunity for some athletes to qualify for the 2010 Olympics and it is expected that the 2013 event will do the same for the 2014 Games in Sochi, Russia.
